Arrow (point) causing puncture wound	Spectators, other participants, instructor	Minimised by instructors briefing. Continuous assessment of equipment and range.	
Arrow (nock) causing puncture wound	participant	Minimised by instructors briefing. Continuous assessment of equipment	
Bowstring friction burn to finger or forearm	participant	Finger tabs and forearm protectors available to use. Instructor visual assessment to minimise harm	
Bowstring friction burn to chest	participant	Minimised by instructors briefing. Instructor visual assessment to minimise harm	
Boss falling over	Participant, instructor	stand suitably secured in place, boss tied to stand	
Other controls in place	Maintained fencing and guard rails. Regular inspection of flooring and arrow catcher Instructors are first aid trained. First aid box
